

Coronavirus Rules

Thank you so much for complying with our new rules to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. We need to implement these rules for the health and safety of ourselves and anyone who comes into the shop during this time. It is possible to be contaminated with the virus anytime you go out, and in reading and signing this document, you release Juliette Bodenchuk, Rachel Burgoyne, and As You Like It Tattoo & Fine Arts from any liability associated with the contraction of COVID-19.

First, if you feel sick, or if you have been exposed to anyone who feels sick, you must cancel your appointment and reschedule once you are clear of any disease. This includes any infection in your body. We are taking this very seriously, and we ask that you do as well. No matter the state of your health, none of us is fully aware of the health of the next person coming in the shop. We all want to be safe, and that requires every person involved being vigilant and compassionate.

If you get sick within two weeks after your tattoo, please inform us right away so that we can take appropriate action with ourselves and our other clients. If you have been sick recently, please cancel your appointment until you are fully recovered, and please bring a doctor's approval that you are recovered when you come in for your appointment.

The new procedures are as follows:

1. No guests are allowed to come with you. The session will be between you and your tattooer.
2. Everyone who comes to the shop (tattooer and client) will take a shower directly before coming to the appointment, with the knowledge that this virus can be living on your body and/or clothes, and a good practice is making sure your clothes and body are as clean as possible before spending one on one time together.
3. We will perform a symptom check for you when you arrive including taking your temperature and asking a series of questions about how you are feeling. If you have a fever or if you have any symptoms, you will be asked to leave. If you are aware of any symptoms that you have, please cancel your appointment ahead of time. You will be required to use hand sanitizer and put on a mask before entering the shop.
4. You will not be allowed to bring food or drink into the shop. Please be sure to eat a solid meal and hydrate well before coming in. Please also bring water for yourself that you can leave in your car to drink after your appointment. In order for our masks to work properly, we must have them on at all times, so no removal for snacks or drinks.
5. When you arrive at the shop, you will knock at the door. Your tattooer will bring you a mask to put on before you enter the shop, unless you previously confirm that you have your own mask with a filter.
6. Once inside the shop, you will immediately go to the bathroom sink to properly wash your hands (warm to hot water, soap, at least 20 seconds of thorough washing).
7. You will sit in the waiting area and fill out your paperwork, then set the paperwork, clipboard, and pen on the table to be disinfected later by your tattooer.
8. Once your tattooer is ready, they will call you back to the tattoo area and the procedure will commence.

9. At the end of the session, we will go over aftercare as usual, take payment, and you will leave the shop. We will only be accepting card payments, to be typed into our system by your tattooer.

I promise to abide by the new COVID-19 rules when I am at As You Like It Tattoo, and I understand that if I do not, I will be asked to leave.
